3 Easy Steps: Login → Enter CE → Submit

The diagram illustrates the three-step process for logging in and entering CE information:

- Login:** The user enters their User ID and Password on the ADA American Dental Association login page.
- Enter CE:** The user fills out the CEU Tracking Submission Form, providing details such as Course Start/End/Expiry Date, Provider Name, Education Category, Course Title, and Course Description.
- Submit:** The user views the Education Unit Summary page, which displays a table of CE records.

The Colorado Dental Association requires members to complete 15 hours of continuing dental education each calendar year.

At least 8 of the 15 hours must be at CE courses designed to enhance dental clinical skills and/or procedures. Hours must be obtained through CE programs offered by an organization that is:

- an American Dental Association Continuing Education Recognition Program (CERP) recognized provider,
- approved by the Academy of General Dentistry Program Approval for Continuing Education (PACE), or
- an American Medical Association Category One continuing medical education course.
