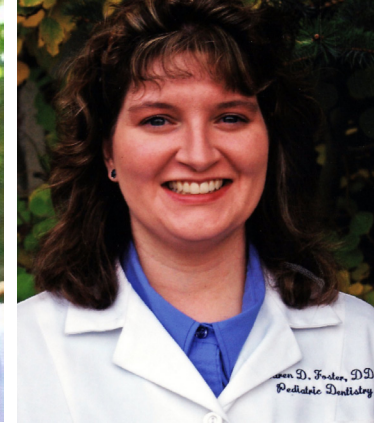
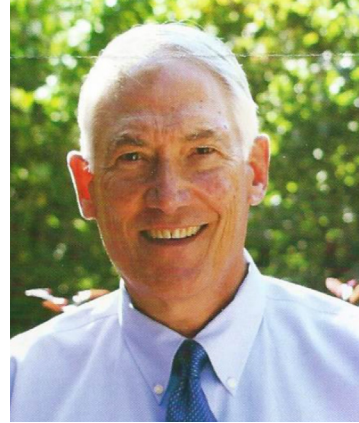


GPs4Kids Seminar Presenters

He then completed a General Practice Residency at National Naval Medical Center in Bethesda, MD and served two years at China Lake Naval Weapons Station in California. After separating from the Navy, he completed a pediatric dentistry residency at The Children's Hospital in Denver where he is an adjunct faculty member.

Dr. Kahl is a past president of the Colorado Academy of Pediatric Dentistry and is the co-chair of the CDA Government Relations Council. He serves as an examiner for the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry and as a consultant on several state health coalitions.
