30

CE credit hours (CERP, AGD, AMA) must be completed each 2-year licensure cycle (16 must be clinical).

years is how long patient records must be retained (or 7 years after a minor turns 18 years old).

2018



is a license renewal year for dentists and hygienists. The deadline to renew is Feb. 28. Renewals start mid-January.

\$1,800

years is how long most CPR and BLS certifications last.
