

King Soopers Scheduling Information

At this time there is a limited amount of COVID vaccine available. During this phased roll out we are currently **prioritizing health care workers and first responders only**. Each eligible provider or health care worker will need to schedule an appointment to be vaccinated. Appointments are first come first serve.


Do not share this link or register for a vaccine if you are not within these prioritized groups. **You will be asked to show proof of employment/occupation at your scheduled appointment.**

Anyone being vaccinated must:

- Be feeling well
- Not currently under quarantine for a COVID exposure within the last 14 days
- Have had no vaccines in the past 14 days

By using the scheduling link below, participants will be able to schedule an appointment for Dose #1.

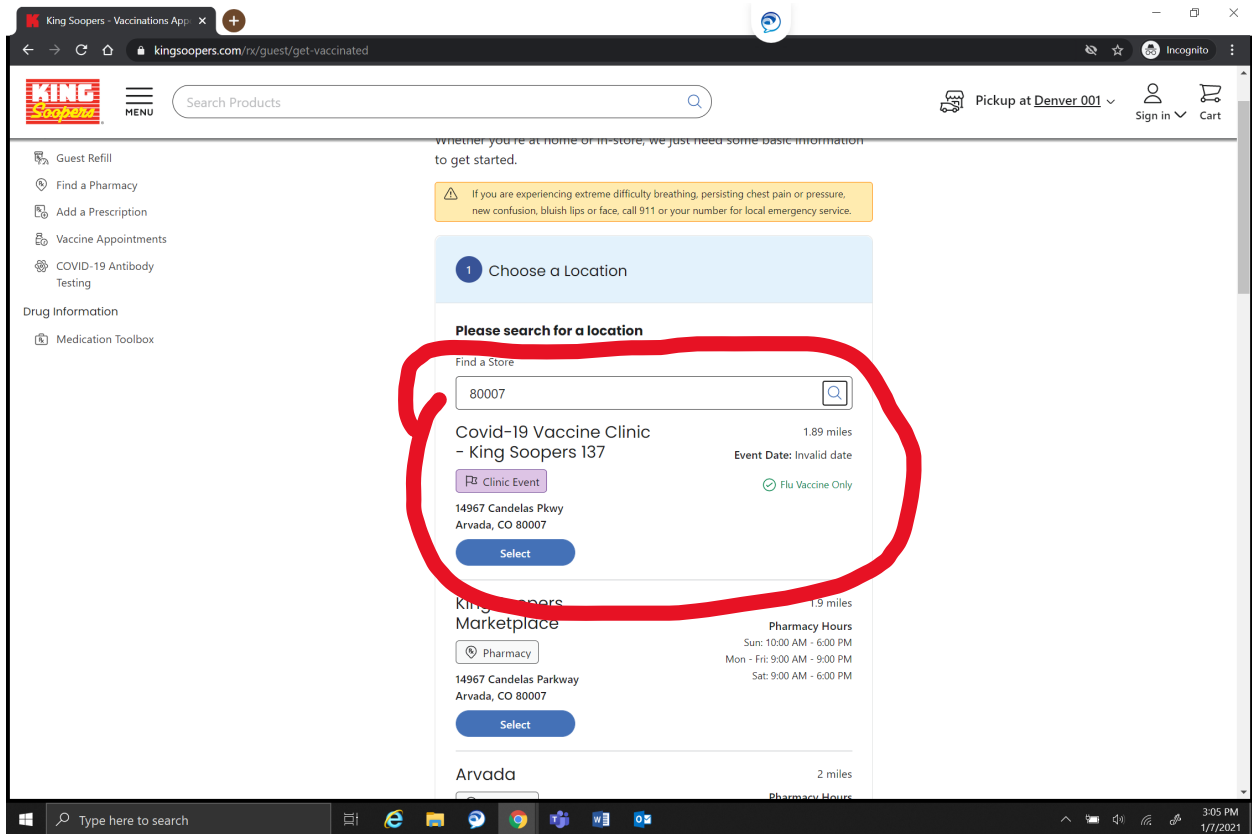
