RESOLVED that the Colorado Dental Association's position statement reflect the position of the DEA that the disclosure of a practitioner's DEA registration number to entities other than those involved in the legal distribution of controlled substances or the enforcement of the laws governing their legal distribution may facilitate the diversion of controlled substances from the legal channels of distribution. RESOLVED that consistent with the position of the DEA that the improper use of the DEA registration number by insurance companies and/or other healthcare providers for identification purposes is contrary to the spirit of the Controlled Substance Act of 1970 and national drug control policies.
